DISCLAIMER: Pattern not yet proofed; test-knit or proof-knit.

if finished/blocked gauge is 4.1 rows per inch (~ 16.5 stitches per 10 cm) this should block out to 84 inches. Choose yarn and needles appropriately.

Cast on 8; join

N = k2tog A= double decrease O = Yarnover T = knit through back loop

Instructions worked 8 times per round until past row 67 - after that it varies.

Rows not numbered are knit plain.

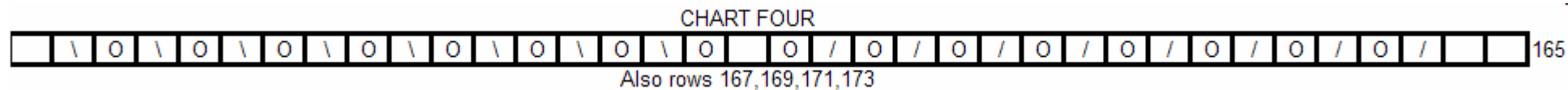

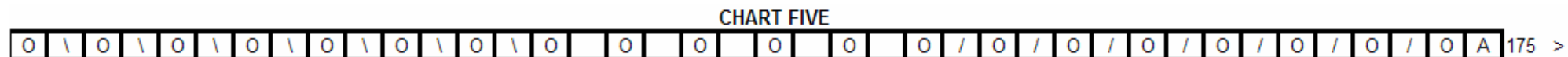
grey background - # of repeats (total) for preceeding group of stitches

165) k2, (NO) x 8; k, (O, skp) x8 , k1 (32 repeats)

167, 169, 171, 173) repeat row 165



175) slip 1 back to left needle; * A (ON) x 7; (OK) x5, O; (skp, O) x7



177) k1, *slip stitch back to left needle, k2tog through back loop.

Block into 32 points. The peak of each point would be the third single knit in the center of chart 5.

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
