

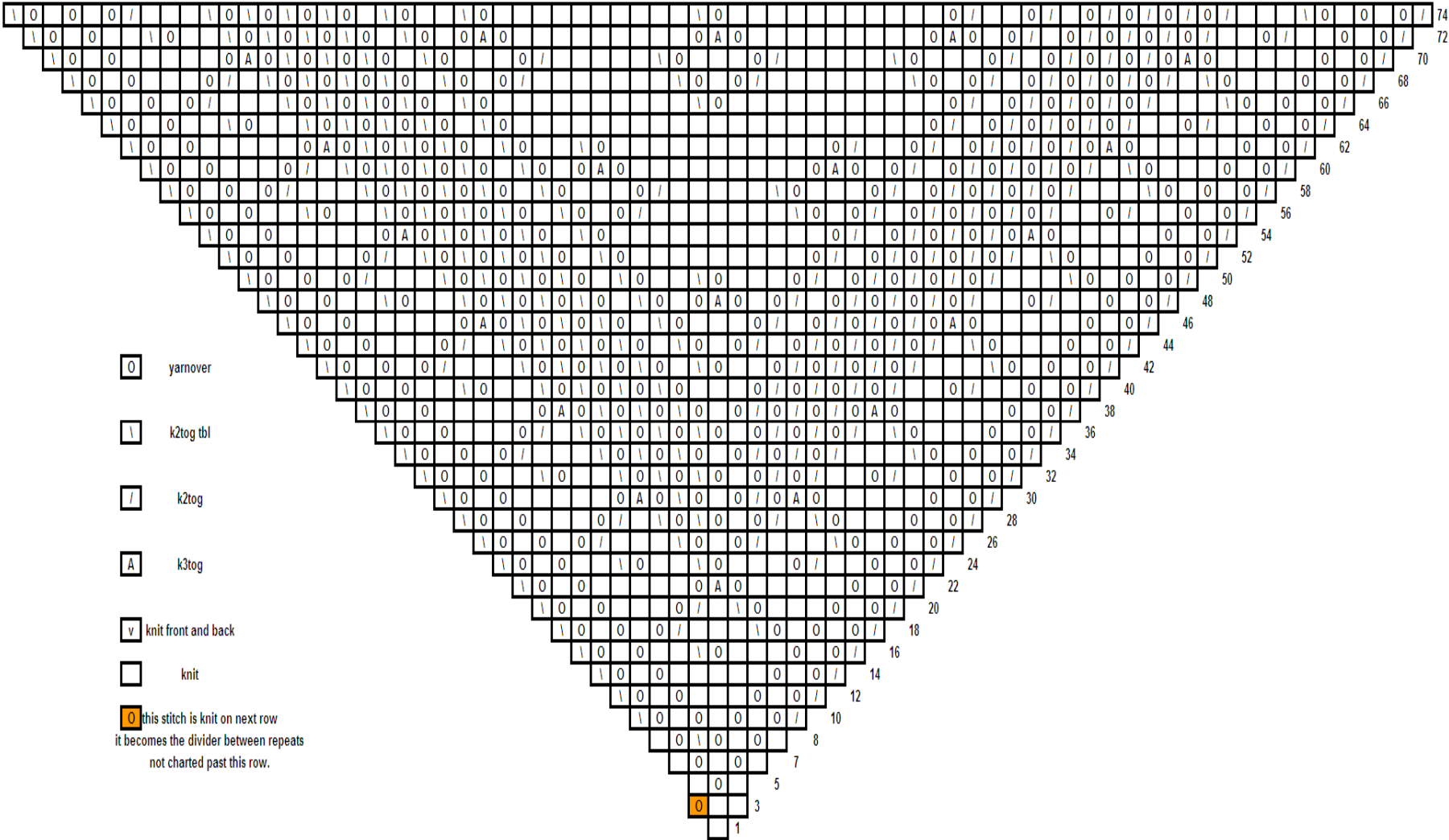
BELLE STAR

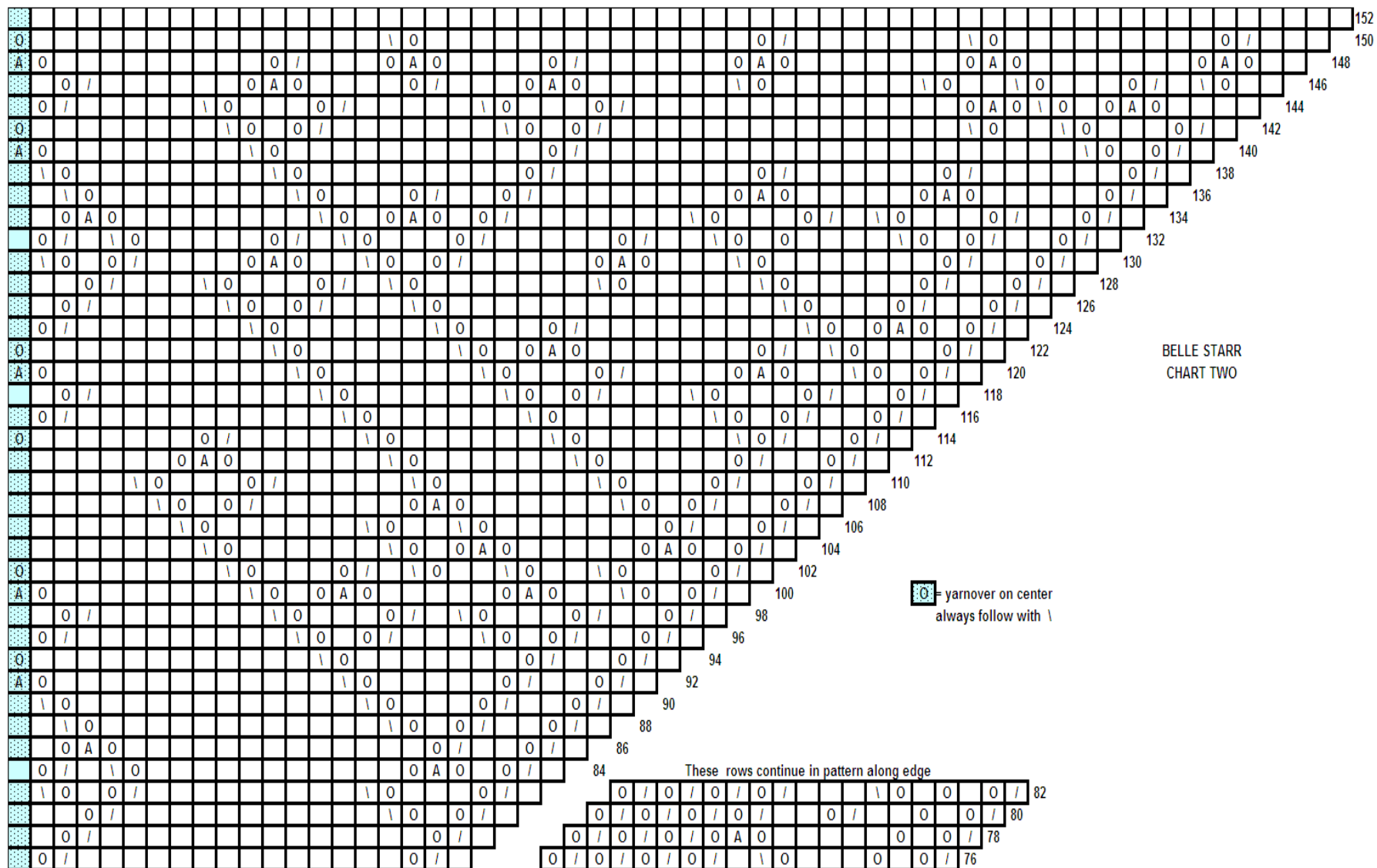
For some odd reason this just reminds me of a famous woman from the Old West (US)



Cast on: 8 stitches. Join and knit around.

Work first chart 4 times per round. Note the left hand stitch of chart row 3 becomes the dividing stitch between repeats of the chart. It is not charted after row 3. With Chart Two - work each chart row from right to left until you have worked the center column; then work back from left to right, reversing the decreases. Knit 1; repeat the row, knitting 1 stitch between repeats until End Of Round.





Note - the first 18 stitches of rows 77 through 83 repeat up the side of the chart though not specifically charted.
When completed row 152 knit plain once around.

Diamond Jim Edge

Cast on 13 using waste yarn.

For the Diamond edge, odd rows work away from the shawl body. Even rows work towards the body of the shawl and the last stitch of the edge is purled together with the next live stitch of the shawl.

Return rows are purled.
