Chart 'A'

General Instructions:

For Each Variation there will be a beginning section that establishes borders and the initial setup row (the un numbered yarnover in Chart 'A') The Chart is a 'half-chart' - each chart row is worked from right to left until the center stitch is reached (shaded column) - the shaded stitch is worked ONCE, then the **same** chart row is worked reading the chart from left to right from the center stitch to the beginning of the row on the chart.

You will probably find it helpful to mark the center stitch, either with a marker either side of the stitch or (my preference) a marker hung from the column of stitches formed by the center stitch.

All un-numbered rows are purled if knitting back and forth, knit if working in the round.

The un-numbered row at the bottom of Chart 'A' is the last setup row. It is not knit as part of Chart 'A'.

CHART B

TRIANGLE VARIATION:

M2 = knit, yo, knit into same stitch

Setup: CO one stitch.

1s) M2

3s)p1, M2, p1

5s)p2, M2, p2

7s) p3, M2, p3

9s) p4, O, p4

This establishes the 4 stitch border on either side of the charted knitting. These stitches are always purled. Work chart 'A' and Chart 'B' by purling the 4 border stitches, working the charted row as per the general instructions, and purling the remaining 4 stitches. All alternate rows are purled.

After knitting the two charts, finish by purling 6 rows and binding off loosely. Wash, block and enjoy.

DOUBLE TRIANGLE:

CO: 4 stitches

knit 5 rows

pickup 3 stitches along edge and 4 stitches from Cast-On = 11 stitches on needle

Setup row - purl 4, O, k1, O, k1, O, k1, O, p4

Mark the three knit stitches, the first and third are the center stitches of the CHART; the middle stitch is the center of the SHAWL. Purl back

Work Chart 'A' and Chart 'B' in the following manner; beginning at row 3:

p4, charted row as per general instructions; shawl center stitch; charted row as per general instructions, p4

All alternate rows are purled.

After knitting the two charts through row 160 , finish by purling 6 rows and binding off loosely. Wash, block and enjoy.

SQUARE -

Setup rows:

Cast on 8 and join and knit around once

Work Chart 'A' and Chart 'B' in the following manner:

[Work chart as per general instructions; knit 1] x4 times per round.

CIRCULAR: - variation A:

Cast on 8, knit around once

Work Chart 'A' and Chart 'B' in the following manner:

reading from right to left ONLY: work each row of chart 8 times in a round.

CIRCULAR: variation B:

(this is appropriate for a smaller sized needle - or you may wish to stop at Row 80, row 103 or row 120)

Cast on 8 stitches, knit around once

1s: (k1, YO) x 8

2s: knit 1 round (16 stitches)

Work Chart 'A' and Chart 'B' in the following manner:

[Work chart as per general instructions; knit 1] x8 per round. ** BUT** knit each NON-charted row 3 times. -

MOCK FAROESE:

CO: 4 stitches using a provisional cast on.

knit 21 rows

Next row: knit 4, pickup 11 stitches along edge and 4 stitches from Cast-On = 19 stitches on needle

Setup row - purl 4, O, k1, O, k9, O, k1, O, p4

Mark the first and last knit stitches, these are the center stitches of the CHART; the 9 stitches in the center will form the center gusset of the SHAWL; mark the 5th (center) and the last of those knit stitches. Purl back

Work Chart 'A' and Chart 'B' in the following manner; beginning at row 3:

p4, charted row as per general instructions; knit across center gusset; charted row as per general instructions, p4

ON ROWS 5, 9,15, 23, 35, 53, 81 and 125 :

p4, charted row as per general instructions;

work the gusset as:

k1, YO, *(k2tog, YO); repeat from * until reach 1 stitch before center stitch of gusset; K, OKO, K; *(O, skip); repeat from * until reach last gusset stitch; O, k1; work the charted row again as per general instructions.

All alternate rows are purled.

After knitting the two charts through row 160 , finish by purling 6 rows and binding off loosely.
