

# NEW DIRECTIONS

AKA

## CHANGE CIRCLE

Much easier if you can "knit backwards"

Needle and yarn size as desired and appropriate:

Prototype used approx 1400 yds on US 8 (5mm) needles

68 inch diameter

"Missing" rows are knit.

Instructions are worked until EOR

### Stitch Key:

O = Yarnover

k=knit

N or / = knit two together

Ñ = k2tog through back loops

A = double decrease

**Cast on:** 10, join and knit once around.



1) Ok

3) kO

7) Ok

11) using waste yarn, cast on 9 to the left needle. Working perpendicular to the body of the shawl:

11.1) slip 1, k1, N, OkO, Ñ, k2

11.2) and all return rows in this section: O, p2tog, p6, purl last stitch together with next live stitch of shawl body.

11.3) slip1, N, O, k3, O, Ñ, k1

11.5) slip 1, k1, Ñ, OkO, N,k2

11.7) skip 1, k8

11.8) as 11.2

Repeat around 19 more times (20 times total):

12) place live stitches on holder; \* pickup and knit 1 yarnover; O; repeat from \* around. (160 stitches)

14) k1, N, OkO, Ñ, k2

16) N, O, k3,O, Ñ, k1

18) k1, Ñ, OkO,N, k2

20) knit

22) k4; \*k1, N, OkO, Ñ, k2 (start of round shifts 4 stitches left)

24) N, O, k3,O, Ñ, k1

26) k1, Ñ, OkO,N, k2

28) knit

29) knit

30) using waste yarn, cast on 24 stitches to the left needle. Working perpendicular to the body of the shawl:

30.1) slip 1, (k1, O, k3, A, k3, O, k1)x2, k1

30.2) and all return rows for this section: O, p2tog, purl until 1 stitch remains, purl last stitch together with next live stitch of shawl body.

30.3) slip 1, (k2, O, k2, A, k2, O, k2)x2; k1

30.5) slip 1, (k3, O, kAk, O, k3)x2; k1

30.7) slip 1, (k4, OAO,k4)x2, k1

30.8) as 30.2

repeat from 30.1 around

31) place live stitches on holder; \* pickup and knit 1 yarnover; O; repeat from \* around. (320 stitches)

32) knit

34) k1, O, k3, A, k3, O

36) k2, O, k2, A, k2, O, k1

38) k3, O, kAk, O, k2

40) k4, OAO, k3

42) knit

44) k1, O, k3, A, k3, O

46) k2, O, k2, A, k2, O, k1

48) k3, O, kAk, O, k2

50) k4, OAO, k3

52) knit

54) k1, O, k3, A, k3, O

56) k2, O, k2, A, k2, O, k1

58) k3, O, kAk, O, k2

60) k4, OAO, k3

62) knit

64) k1, O, k3, A, k3, O

66) k2, O, k2, A, k2, O, k1

68) k3, O, kAk, O, k2

86) k4; \*k1, N, OkO, Ñ, k2 (start of round shifts 4 stitches left)

88) N, O, k3, O, Ñ, k1

90) k1, Ñ, OkO, N, k2

92) knit

94) k4; \*k1, N, OkO, Ñ, k2 (start of round shifts 4 stitches left)

96) N, O, k3,O, Ñ, k1

98) k1, Ñ, OkO,N, k2

100) knit

102) k4; \*k1, N, OkO, Ñ, k2 (start of round shifts 4 stitches left)

104) N, O, k3,O, Ñ, k1

106) k1, Ñ, OkO,N, k2

108) knit

110) k1, O, k6, A, k6, O

112) k2, O, k5, A, k5, O, k1

114) k3, O, k4, A, k4, O, k2

116) k4, O, k3, A, k3, O, k3

118) k5, O, k2, A, k2, O, k4

120) k6, O, kAk, O, k5

122) k7, OAO, k6

Repeat rows 110 to 123 twice more. Bind off loosely.

Return to the sections where provisional cast on was used. Graft/sew together the stitches on the holder with the stitches on the provisional cast on. Weave in any loose ends.

This should block into gentle scallops.
