

PI-NEAPPLE STRUDEL

Influenced by Pi shaping; any similarities are rapidly lost.

A circular BS Johnsen Design imitating crochet.

Testknit, proofing and transcription of charts by Judi Farley

Yardage Required: approx 2200 yards

Needles Suggested : 4.5 mm

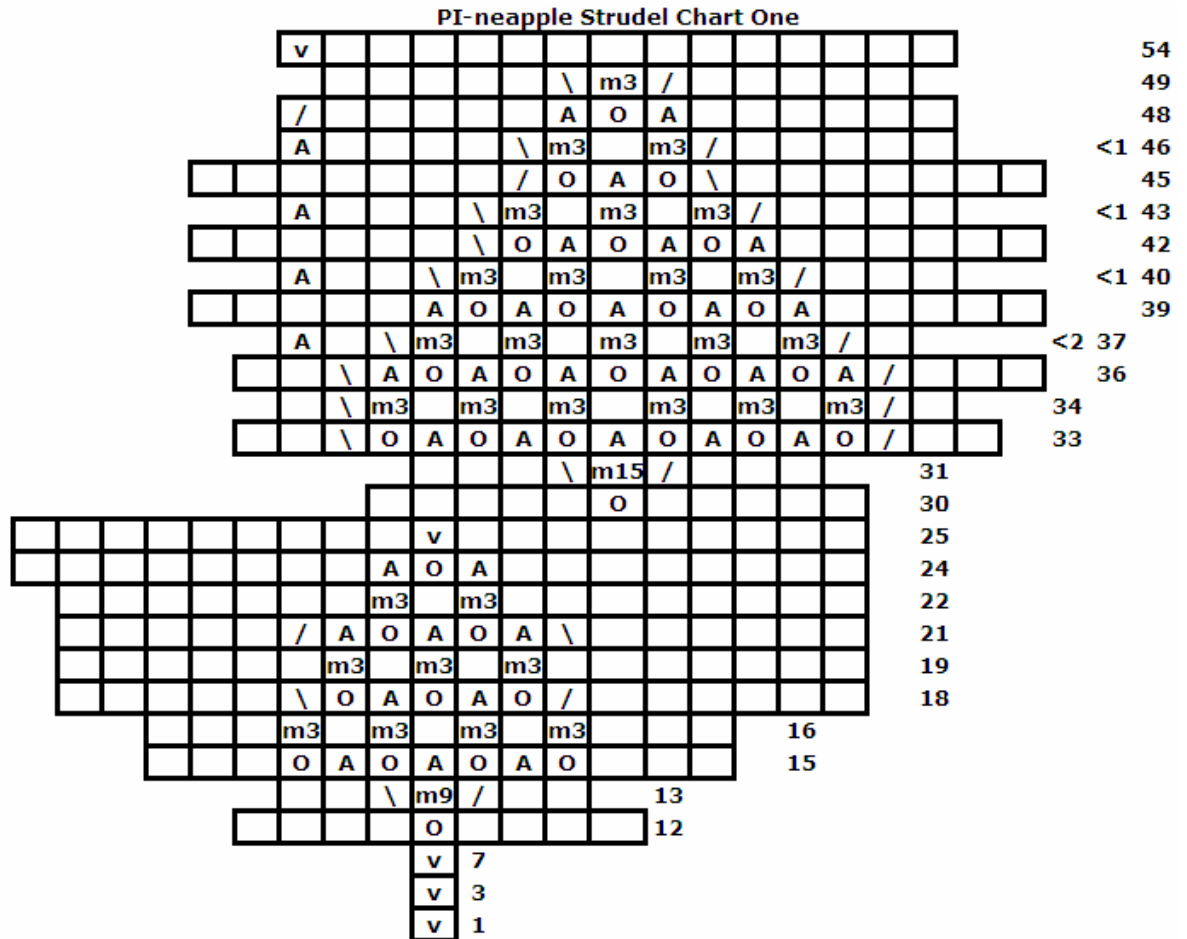
Yarn Suggested: fingering to lace



Cast on: 8; join and knit around once.

Chart is repeated until End of Round.

Rows not charted are knit plain.



STITCH KEY:

A = centered double decrease (s2,k1, pss0)

/ = right leaning decrease (k2tog)

\ = left leaning decrease (k2togtbl or skp or ssk)

O = yarnover

Blank box = knit

v = knit front and back in single stitch

m3 = k2togtbl in single stitch

m9 = k4tog in single stitch

m15 = k7tog in single stitch

<# = move start of round # stitches to the left. In the written instructions this occurs as [k#; *] at the beginning of the round; the repeat being from the asterick.

Chart One - written instructions: number in parentheses is the number of stitches per repeat

Cast on 8 and knit around once.

Rows not written are knit plain.

Notes: Chart Two is repeated - see the line numbers of the second repeat on the right of the chart. Row 155 - the 'v' stitch w/ orange background is worked as a plain knit stitch on row 155.

After completing row 155 knit on the simple edge.

Cast on 6

Inward row:

p2tog, O, k3, O, k2tog

Outward row:

slip one, p2tog, p4

Work until all the body stitches of the shawl are "bound off" by the edge, Graft/sew or otherwise join final row to cast on edge.
