Test knit on Size US 8 (5mm) needles using approx 1000 yards laceweight wool from HandPaintedYarn.com



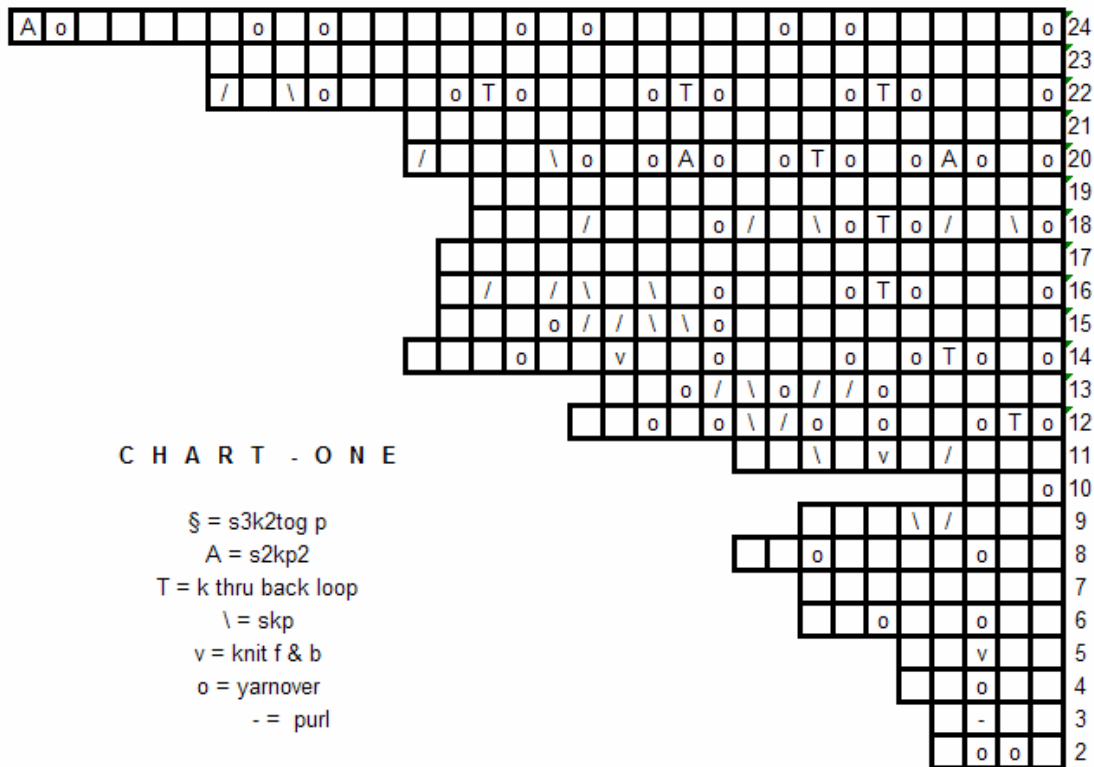
**A visual rendition of the Spanish Armada

SPANISH ARMADA

T = knit through back loop; N=k2tog A = slip 2 knit-wise, k1, pass 2 slipped stitches over
 § = slip 3 knit-wise, k2tog, p3sso k = knit; O = Yarn-over

Rows not specifically mentioned are knit plain.

Cast on 8, join and knit around.

Notes on the Make three in loop, make 4 in loop, make 9 in loop. These are all worked into a single stitch, usually a yo of the previous row. I use alternating k, yo to make the stitches, for the make 4, since it is an even number I (knit, yo, knit, knit through back loop). You may, if you prefer alternate k1,p1 to the appropriate number, or knit front, knit back.
