

Border B: -

KOK in corner stitch. Knit to next corner. Repeat around. 113 stitches per side

1) k1,*KO x3 k3,0 ; repeat from * to next corner; repeat all 3 more times.

2) k1, 0 * NK x2; AK ; repeat from * to next corner; 0; repeat all 3 more times

3) k2, *O, k3, OK x3; repeat from * until 1 stitch remains before corner. k1; repeat all x3

4) k1, 0,k1*KA; KN x2; repeat from * until 1 stitch remains before corner, k1, O; repeat all x3

5) k3, *KO x3; k3,0; repeat from * until 2 from corner; k2; repeat all x3

6) k1, 0, k2; *NK x2; AK; repeat from * until 2 from corner; k2, O; repeat all x3

repeat these 6 rows 3 times more.

136 stitches per side plus corner stitch

Repeat Border A rows 1 - 12 Once, using 14 repeats of the 10 stitch section

CATSPAWE EDGE:

Use waste yarn to cast on provisionally 10 stitches. With the unbroken working yarn:

1) k2, O, K2tog, k2, O, k1, O, k3

2) purl back until reach the first YO; O, P2tog; Purl last stitch together with next free stitch on shawl. (all even rows performed the same way unless specified - see note below)

3) S1, k1, O, k2tog, k2, O, k3, O, k3

5) S1,k1, O, k2tog, k4, O, k1, O, k5

7) S1, knit 15

8) Knit 1, Bind off 6 , finish as normal for even rows.

NOTE: On the first two and last two repeats on each side, (either side of corner) connect to the live stitches of shawl body on rows 2, and 6 only. For other repeats connect on each inward row. I believe this works out to 39 repeats per side .

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
